As expected, on March 7th, The European Payments Council confirmed that the UK will retain its membership of SEPA even in the event that it leaves the EU without a deal.

Clients can continue to use their existing preferred payment method for cross-border payments into and out of the UK. EUR flows to and from the UK will continue in the same manner post-Brexit, regardless of the political outcome (deal or no deal).
